# How to book

#### For groups that want to use the Pre & Post options:

- Book your accommodation at <u>travel@skatarnir.is</u>.
   Keep in mind that indoor accommodation is in very limited supply, so act fast. Campers can be a little more relaxed.
- 2. To secure your accommodation, an invoice will be issued for a confirmation fee, payable by bank transfer.
- 3. Once the confirmation fee is paid, you can start to plan your activities and fill in the CART form for catering, activities, rental and transport.
- 4. Once you have your plan ready, send the CART form in, and you will be issued a final invoice.

#### For groups that only need transportation and/or equipment:

- 1. Fill in the CART form and send in to <a href="mailto:travel@skatarnir.is">travel@skatarnir.is</a>.

  You will get an invoice for confirmation fee.
- 2. Once the confirmation fee is paid, the booking is confirmed and a final invoice is issued.





#### Whale watching: Hauganes

### River rafting - day trip

Would you like some extra thrills? Raft the famous Jökulsá Vestari, a glacial river with class 2-3 rapids. Coach, rafting, wetsuits and entry to hot tubs included. Bring swimsuits, long sleeved fleece and a towel. Thermals are a recommended optional, but no cotton!

# Diamond circle - Guided day trip

The Diamond Circle is a magnificent circuit of 250km in North Iceland, which includes some of the most stunning sights and spots for unearthly landscapes.

The five key destinations include the historical and picturesque Goðafoss, the unearthly blue and green landscapes of Lake Mývatn nature paradise, the uncontrollable white energy of Dettifoss, the most powerful waterfall of Europe, the crescent-shaped wonder of Ásbyrgi canyon and Húsavík the buzzing whale watching capital of Iceland with the deep blue seas ahead.

# Mývatn - Guided day trip

Explore the natural wonders around lake Mývatn. Visit Dimmuborgir (the Dark Fortress) - huge lava formations that make you feel like you stepped into another world. See the boiling mud and hot springs of Námaskarð geothermal field. Visit Grjótagjá, a former underground geothermal bathing place, made world famous in Games of Thrones. Lake Mývatn itself was created by a large basaltic lava eruption 2300 years ago, and the surrounding landscape (which is very rich in biological activity) is dominated by volcanic landforms.

# Húsavík - Guided day trip

"My hooooomeeeeeetooooown," sang Rachel McAdams' character in the hit movie Eurovision Song Contest - The story of Fire Saga. Húsavík is not only famous for the movie, whale watching and stunning nature, but also as the first place in Iceland to be settled by a Norseman around 870 A.D.

Enjoy a guided tour to Húsavík, with a stop at Goðafoss waterfall. In Húsavík you will have 4 hours to explore the town before heading back. Check out local museums, bathing lagoon or restaurants, or go whale watching.

# Golden Circle - Guided day trip

The Golden Circle is Iceland's most famous scenic route. It is a round-trip sightseeing tour that combines stunning landmarks and historically significant places.

Gullfoss waterfall in Hvítá river is a cascading waterfall with

100 000 liters of water plunging 31 meters (100 feet) every second!

Geysir geothermal area is the home of the original Geysir (that all geysers are named after). It's little brother Strokkur gustes every 8-10 minutes, up to 30 meters (100 feet) into

Pingvellir national park is famous for it's geology as well as history. From the age of settlement (930 AD) until 1789, it was the home of the Icelandic parliament Alþingi. Lake Þingvallavatn sits on a rift valley where the Euroasian and American tectonic plates are slowly drifting apart.



On the way back you will stop at famous waterfalls Skógafoss and Seljalandsfoss.

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
