



## Patrol Competition

Up until Jamboree 2026, monthly tasks will be shared. Each task can be solved by the patrols together with their leaders. The purpose of the tasks is to strengthen the group, train new skills, and prepare the patrol for the final competition, which will take place at Jamboree 2026.

There are 7–8 tasks in total leading up to the Jamboree.

It is not required to submit all tasks, but the more tasks a patrol completes and submits, the greater the advantage they will receive in points.

## Scoring

- Each task is evaluated according to a scoring scale, and the patrol collect points this way.
- For participation the patrol receives 1 point.
- In the final competition, there will be variety of challenges.
- The patrol with the highest overall points will receive a generous trophy and prizes.

## Submitting tasks

Submissions can be in the form of photos, videos and text, or other creative means.

It is important to show that the task was completed and who participated in it.

When submitting it is important to include:

- Patrol name
- Scout group
- Age group

## Rating scale

Each project can receive up to 10 points.

Category	Description	Maximum score
1. Task execution	The task is completed according to instructions, showing good preparation and cooperation within the patrol.	0-2
2. Knowledge and skills	The participants demonstrate understanding of the subject and can explain it or show confident practical skills.	0-2
3. Creative approach	The task is carried out with creativity, original ideas or new methods.	0-2
4. Presentation	How the task is presented (photos, video, narration, etc.). Clarity, neatness, and overall quality of presentation.	0-2
5. Scout spirit and teamwork	The task reflects scout values: cooperation, initiative, respect and a positive attitude.	0-2
